



Brought to life and presented in a large exhibition in 2006 the project **WOMEN ON THE LINE** wants to REawaken.

They exist, they have always existed, and they will always exist - they are many, very many. But hardly anyone knows them: women in history and at present, in all times and throughout all cultures, making wondrous accomplishments in politics, in fighting for rights that actually should be taken for granted, in science and research, in economics and ecology, in arts, culture, everywhere in our everyday lives.

Official histories with a few exceptions –generally dedicate little room and little significance to women’s history, as they do with the biographies of women and their stories detail. Although feminist research for more than 40 years has been making every effort to make women visible, it is still a fact that the larger half of mankind is still denied the social attention it is due.

Women and men worldwide now have the chance to contribute with biographies of women they feel closely attached to (such as mother, friend, sister, daughter, lover, aunt, cousin, librarian, grandchild, grandmother, niece, neighbour, teacher, priest, saleswoman, foe, musician, journalist...etc.) or to write or encourage autobiographies, based on the motto

in order to provide an even broader spectrum of the contributions of little known or hardly known interesting women and their life stories.

Take the chance to make female (hi)stories visible and take part in writing or inspiring them to be written, to collect a broad spectrum of stories about hardly known or completely unknown women.
